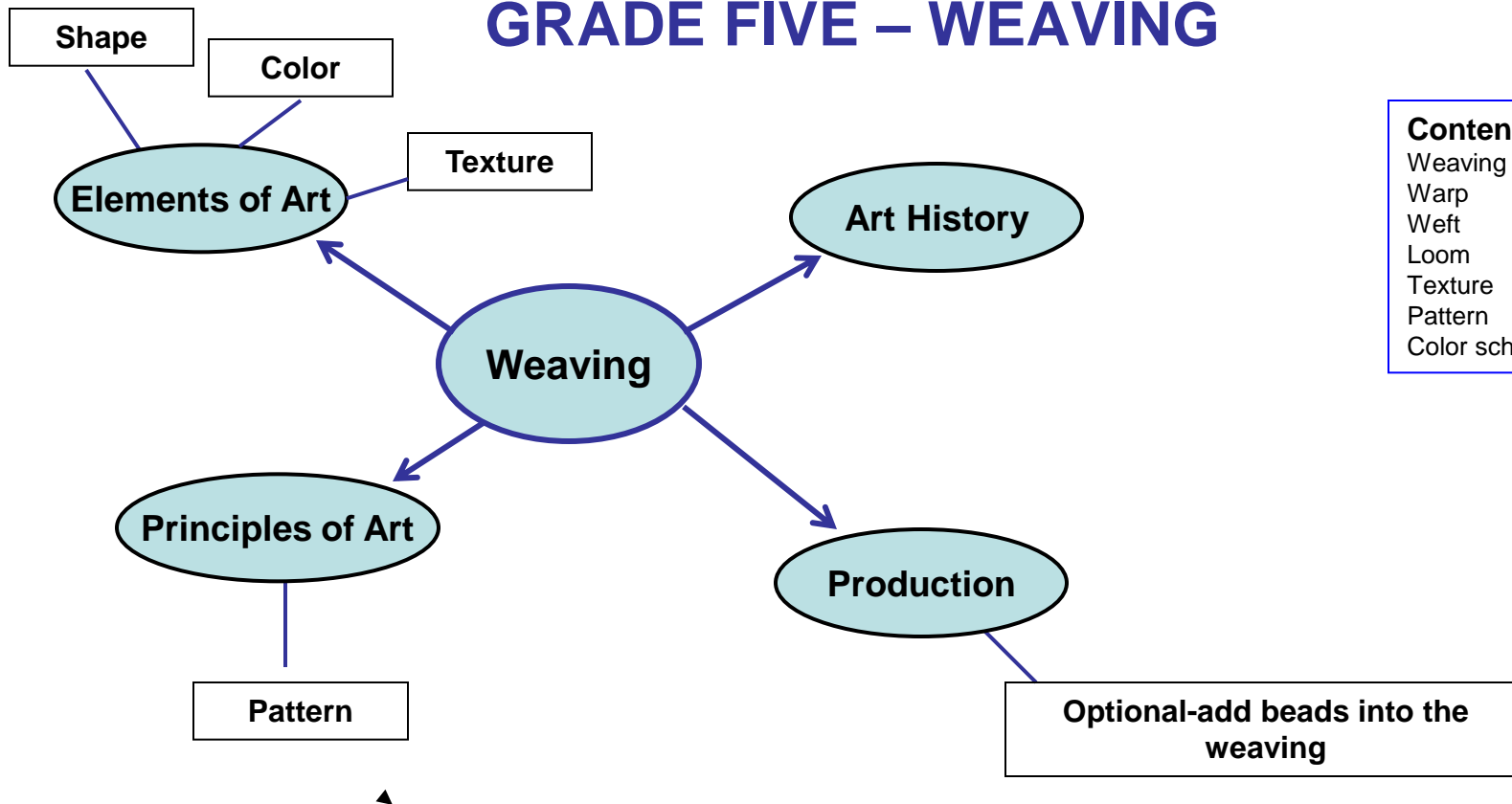

Essential Understandings/Questions:

- Weaving is when you interlock two fibers.
- A loom is the support for the fibers you weave.
- The warp fibers are the vertical threads that are attached to the loom.
- The warp must be made first because the weft fibers are woven over and under it.
- If the fibers do not alternate and do not interlock, the weaving will come apart when it is removed from the loom.
- A pattern is created by repeating an element of art.
- Color schemes are plans for organizing colors such as primary, secondary, neutral, monochromatic, complementary, warm and cool colors.
