PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The current Notifier Alarm System at Tolland Middle School AFP-400 is becoming obsolete and parts are becoming less and less available. Newer panels will allow for better monitoring and offer third party monitoring which will improve communication regarding addressable signals: troubles, supervisory, alarm, etc. The price has been increased by \$14,000 over the prior year's figures to take into consideration current code requirements that would result in exterior improvements with horns and strobes to indicate that the building is in alarm for exterior occupants.
