FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE:



Last week the TIS HAWK Community once again participated in Start with Hello Week! Start With Hello is a program founded by the Sandy Hook Promise Organization. The program is designed to bring individuals and school communities together to foster looking out and caring for one another. Young people have the power to see someone, reach out and Start with Hello in order to reduce social isolation and create a more connected and inclusive school. Each student has the power to make a difference and make a new friend.

Relationship Building

Over the course of the first weeks of school, staff have emphasized getting students acclimated to being part of a school again. As a school community, we place a high level of importance on the social and emotional well-being of our students. The relationship building process has included staff utilizing small group meeting time to teach students about new school-related procedures and the purpose behind such procedures.

Our school mantra is One School One Team TIS. The mantra embodies our goal of creating an all-inclusive school community in which all members are important members of our TIS Team. The bracelets include our grade-level colors of grade 3 - green, grade 4 - red and grade 5 - blue as well as our unified arts color of yellow. The staff bracelets are meant to serve as a reminder that together we are One School, One Team, TIS.

Universal Screening

All T.I.S. students have been engaged in the process of participating in universal screens for reading and math. The universal screens enable us to monitor the progress of all students in relation to grade expectations for reading and math. Information from universal screens is analyzed by teachers, reading and math interventionists, administrators and curriculum supervisors. Universal screening is done three times per year.

Morning Drop off - Student drop off is located in the parking lot directly in front of TIS. Students may be dropped off beginning at 8:30. A staff member will be stationed in the drop off lane each morning from 8:30 – 8:45. Students

arriving after 8:45 must be walked into the building by a parent or guardian and signed in at the main office.

To help ensure the safety of our students, the driveway in front is reserved for bus traffic only. Please do not drive in the bus lane. Visitor parking is located in front of T.I.S. If you are visiting TIS, please use one of the designated visitor parking spaces located in the front lot.

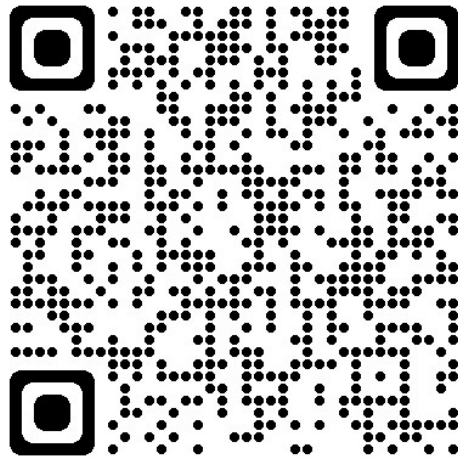

Introduction:

Tolland Travel Basketball is an organization that provides opportunities and training for girls to become competitive basketball players. Girls will gain a foundation of skills and understanding of the game so they can continue playing in high school and beyond.

Commitment:

The player's experience will depend on the level of commitment they give to practices and games.

- Late October-Early March
- Practice 2 times a week for approximately 75 mins per practice
 - All practices will take place at a Tolland School
- 1-2 games on the weekend (mostly 1)
 - Most games are within a 15-minute drive. The furthest is 35.
- Preseason tournament in November (Thanksgiving weekend)

Ages/Teams:

Girls in grade level 5-8: Advanced 4th graders can also tryout. Every season, the number of teams that Tolland fields depend on the number of girls that sign up. Typically, each grade level has one team; however, there have been many years in which two grade levels combine for one team.

Selectivity/Cuts:

As mentioned above, every season is different. Coaches will evaluate players, make thoughtful decisions, and have conversations with each family regarding the outcomes/decisions made.

Cost:

\$300 per player. Please bring a check, made out to Tolland Travel Basketball on the first day of tryouts. If your child is not selected, your check will be returned or destroyed. Venmo and cash are also payment options. If you are unable to cover all/some of the player fees, please let us know.

Students have two Band classes per week (small group and Full Ensemble) during the school day. Small group instruction classes will begin during the week of September 18, 2023. 

School Meals 2023-2024:

All students are eligible for a free breakfast each day. Students who qualify for free or **reduced-price meals** will also be eligible to receive one free lunch daily. **ALL OTHER LUNCHES WILL BE CHARGED AT THE CURRENT LUNCH PRICE PER SCHOOL.**

Payment for these lunches is the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

The district participates in the National School Lunch Program and Breakfast Program which offers students nutritionally balanced meals daily. The lunch period is 30 minutes. Proper manners are always expected in the cafeteria. Free and reduced-price meals are available based on financial need. Information on this program may be obtained from the main office or Abby Kassman-Harned, the Food Service Director, at aharned@tolland.k12.ct.us or 870-6854.

We use a Point-of-Sale System that allows you to put money into an account for your child to purchase meals.

Scanning – All students will be scanned unless the parent or guardian opts out of this biometric identification procedure. When your child comes through the service line, he/she will scan his/her finger as a means of identification.

Payments – The cost of lunch at Birch Grove and Tolland Intermediate school is \$3.15. One school breakfast is free for all students. One milk is provided for each lunch and breakfast. Ala carte milk is \$0.75. You may sign up for [“My School Account”](#) and make your payments online. Your child may give payment along with a form to his/her classroom teacher to send to the office, or he/she may bring payment directly to the cashier in the cafeteria at mealtime. Your payment may take us a few days to process. It is important to keep a positive balance in your students’ accounts. 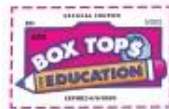
